

# Arkabutla Creek Watershed Project

## Update – August 2010



The Arkabutla Creek Watershed Project consists of construction of lining with rock riprap the lower portions of the banks of stream segments that are eroding, constructing several sediment basins equipped to pipe storm runoff into the natural drainage, and installing any necessary fish and wildlife habitat mitigation features. The funding for this project, at approximately \$1,000,000, is through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.
